How May I Be Certain of Heaven?

The Bible says that those who know Christ as their Savior may know that they have eternal life (1 John 5:13).

Why do I need a Savior? “For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God” (Romans 3:23). “... the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord,” (Romans 6:23).

Where did sin come from? “Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned.” (Romans 5:12)

Jesus paid the price for our sins. “But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us” (Romans 5:8).

What do I need to do? Turn away from your sin and receive Christ as your Savior - *trusting Him alone.*

“Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out...” (Acts 3:19a)

“That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.” (Romans 10:9)

“For God so loved the world, that he gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life.” (John 3:16)
